Latin II
1st Six Weeks Syllabus

Student Expectations: Students will learn class expectations and procedures, review grammar and vocabulary. They will count from 1-30 in Latin, and how to use read and translate Latin numerals, as well as use them in simple math problems. They will learn common Latin phrases.

August 24 : The classes will review procedures for Everyday Latin. They will be issued textbooks and will go over the code of conduct and material for the class. They will read “Taberna Crustalaria”, learn Latin cardinal numerals from 1-30. They will do stated math problems in Latin, and will review Latin nouns, verbs, declensions, conjugations. They will learn Latin Phrases XIVa.

Student Expectations: Students will learn the present tense of sum. They will learn accusative of place to which. They will learn new vocabulary, will translate, and read orally. They will review Latin numerals from 1-30, and learn Latin phrases.

August 31: The classes will review vocabulary and Latin cardinal numerals from 1-30. They will begin Lesson XV and will learn present tense of the verb “to be”(sum), and accusative of place to which. They will translate sentences, and will translate orally the story “Coloni Romani”. They will do Workbook Lesson XV, and they will learn and practice Latin classroom phrases. They will learn and be tested over Latin Phrases XIV.

Student Expectations: Students will review vocabulary, present tense of sum. They will learn the neuter nouns of the second conjugation, and will translate and will be tested over vocabulary. They will learn Latin phrases, and classroom conversational phrases.

September 8: The students will begin Lesson XVI, where they will learn neuters of the second declension. They will translate the sentences in Exercises A & B. They will do Workbook Lesson XVI. They will also read orally, “Troia”, and be tested over vocabulary XV and Latin numerals 1-30. They will learn Latin Phrases XVa. They will practice classroom conversational phrases.

Student Expectations: Students will learn future and perfect forms of sum. They will learn new vocabulary, will translate, and read orally. They will practice classroom conversation, and learn Latin phrases.

September 14: The classes will review vocabulary, and classroom conversation. They will begin Lesson XVII, and will learn future and perfect of the verb “to be”(sum), and learn the infinitive uses as a subject and as an object. They will translate sentences in Ex. A & B, and will translate orally the story “Romulus, Numa et Tullus”. They will do Workbook Lesson XVII. They will learn and be tested over Latin Phrases XV b.

Student Expectations: Students will learn to ask questions in Latin. They will learn new vocabulary, will translate, and read orally. They will learn new Latin Phrases.

September 21: Students will begin Lesson XVIII in which they will learn to ask questions in Latin. They will do Ex. A & B and Workbook Lesson XVIII. They will begin translating "Spartacus" for their six weeks test. They will turn in Everyday Latin and begin reviewing for the six weeks tests

Students Expectations: Students will review questioning in Latin, the present, future, and perfect tenses of sum, neuter nouns of the second declension. They will review vocabulary, and will translate.

September 28: Students will work on the six weeks review of present, future, and perfect tenses of sum, neuter nouns of the second declension, as well as vocabulary from Lessons XV-XVIII. They will translate "Spartacus" p. 130, and will take their six week test.
