Latin III
1st Six Weeks Syllabus

Student Expectations: Students will learn class expectations and procedures, begin to review grammar and vocabulary. They will learn the names of the body parts in Latin, how to identify, translate, and write sentences with them. They will review noun and adjective forms, as well as cases and case uses.

August 24 : The classes will read “Dr. Frankenpetrus”, and use the story to learn how to understand the Latin names of body parts. They will answer questions over the story, match sentences to pictures and answer questions in Latin. They will go over the student Code of Conduct, the Student Handbook, and “Tools of the Trade”, their material list for Latin. They will begin Lesson I in which they will review vocabulary, noun and adj. Of the 1st and 2nd declensions, forms, cases and uses. They will have a test over Latin body parts. They will learn five Latin phrases from Latin Phrase List XXVIII a.

Student Expectations: Students will continue their review of nouns, adjs., cases and case uses. They will review vocabulary, 3rd declension nouns and adjectives, ablative of accompaniment, dative of indirect object, and they will practice translating sentences. They will learn new Latin phrases and be tested over them.

August 31: The classes will do and complete Workbook Lesson I, have their materials checked, will complete any unfinished work over “Dr. Frankenpetrus”. They will begin Lesson II in which they will review vocabulary, 3rd declension nouns and adjectives, ablative of accompaniment, dative of indirect object. They will learn Latin Phrase List XXVIII b and have a phrase test.

Student Expectations: Students will continue their review of 3rd declension nouns and adjs., ablative of accompaniment, and dative of indirect object. They will translate sentences, and complete the review. They will be tested over review vocabulary and will learn Latin phrases.

September 8: Students will translate sentences from Lesson II over 3rd declension nouns and adjs., ablative of accompaniment and dative of indirect objects. They will write sentences on the board and correct them. They will do Workbook Lesson II. They will review vocabulary and will be tested over Lesson I. They will learn new Latin Phrases in List XXIX a.

Student Expectations: Students will review vocabulary, 3rd and 4th conjugation verbs, ablative of means and infinitive subjects and objects. They will be tested over vocabulary, and will learn new Latin phrases. They will translate and read.

September 14: The students will complete Lesson II by grading and checking Lesson II Workbook, and being tested over vocabulary II. They will begin Lesson III in which they will review 3rd and 4th conjugation verbs, ablative of means, and infinitive objects and subjects. They will translate sentences and do Workbook Lesson III. They will learn new Latin phrases, and will be tested on Phrase List XXIX b.

Student Expectations: Students will review vocabulary and perfect, past perfect, future perfect tense verbs. They will review genitive of possession and partitive genitive. They will be tested over vocabulary, will turn in Everyday Latin, turn in all make-up work and will begin translating a story.

September 21: Students will begin Lesson IV, in which they will review perfect, past perfect, and future perfect verb forms from all conjugations. They will review genitive of possession and partitive genitive, will translate sentences and do Workbook Lesson IV. They will have Vocabulary Test III & IV, will do and turn in Everyday Latin. They will begin reviewing for their six weeks test, and will begin translating a story for their six weeks test.

Student Expectations: Students will review vocabulary, forms, syntax and grammar. They will translate a story, and will watch a video over Roman culture and history.

September 28: The class will review vocabulary, forms, syntax and grammar from Lessons I-IV. They will translate a story as part of their six weeks test. They will take their six weeks test, and will watch Pt. I of "Rome: Power and Glory, The Rise".
