Participation in AP courses and exams gives students the chance to get a head start on the sort of work they will encounter in college, and to show colleges that they are ready for that challenge. Most U.S. colleges and universities grant credit, advanced placement, or both to students whose **AP Exam grades meet** their requirements.
